### **Transitions**

It is May 5, 2008 as I write this and I am deeply immersed in consideration of the power and possibility generated by the fixed energy of Sun and Moon in Taurus.

This is a powerful time for new beginnings: Spring season, New Moon, and a Ten vibration 1 year on the Julian calendar. Returning to my comment that we are in a ten vibration "1" year,  $2+0+0+8$  equals 10.  $1+0$  equals 1. Another way to think of this is to consider that the number one marks the beginning. It is the smallest whole number that "has" value. Place it alone, before any number and nothing changes; but, place it alone behind any number and you increase that number tenfold. So 2008 has the extra oomph of zero exponentially.

It is this same zero that begins the Tarot deck. Zero is the number traditionally assigned to the Fool. The Fool is the Divine as seeker choosing to incarnate. It is this choice that drives everything. Zero represents the impulse that drove the Infinite to express Itself and thus Creation occurred. That Infinite resides in each and everyone of us as each and everyone of us reside in the Infinite. Therefore, everything is possible especially from nothing.

In closing, two represents balance, partnership, yin/yang and eight represents power, structure, money. The two zeros in the center remind us of an infinity sign, an eight turned on its side. Taurus is ruled by Venus the Goddess of love and therefore abundance, she loves two because of all that becomes of two when influenced by the power of love. Eight is a number of Saturn: Father Time, task master, wise old man who understands and appreciates the power that comes from discipline and structure. 2 and 8 enhanced by double zero. Let your Divine Self and your mundane self reconnect. Let them chat in order that the small you be energized by the All of you. And may all of your dreams be realized.
